Personal information for the Nijmegen Career Event

The Nijmegen Career Event processes your personal data when you make use of our services. The Nijmegen Career Event processes personal information for the following purposes:

- To give access to the login portal of the Nijmegen Career Event website (www.nijmegencareerevent.nl);
- To provide the opportunity to register for the Nijmegen Career Event;
- To send emails with personal information regarding the Nijmegen Career Event.

The Nijmegen Career Event processes personal data via the registration form. Below is a list of the personal data collected through the registration form and for what purposes it is collected. Table 1 explains the different personal data and the purposes of said data.

First name, initials, inserts and last name	To distinguish between participants and to address participants correctly
Geslacht	To address participants correctly
Phone number	To be able to contact in case of an emergency, to get in touch for cv selections and to clarify/answer ambiguities and/or questions
Email	To announce announcements and to send personal information regarding the Nijmegen Career Event
Bank details (IBAN and bank account holder name)	In order to collect participation money
Curriculum Vitae	To give participants the opportunity to participate in events with CV selection
Study information	To distinguish between the study phases and specializations of different participants
Membership of the study association	To assess membership status of participant
Allergies	To ensure that allergies are taken into account during lunch at the Nijmegen Career Event

The purpose of this information is to ensure successful participation of the event. This information is only used for the event. The accounts on the website and the personal information associated with them will be kept for up to a month after the event.

Sharing personal information

The personal data collected through the registration form or by registering an activity at the event is stored in a secure digital membership file, which is only accessible to the organisation of the Nijmegen Career Event, the board of both study associations (Synergy and the ESV) and the website administrators.

The website administrators have signed a processing agreement. In addition, if you sign up for an activity of a participating company, your name will be shared with that company. When you sign up for a resume selection, your resume is shared with the company.

By agreeing to this privacy statement, you agree that the Nijmegen Career Event uses the aforementioned personal data for the aforementioned purposes.

Cookies

The website of the Nijmegen Career Event ([nijmegencareerevent.nl](https://www.nijmegencareerevent.nl)) uses technical and functional cookies. In addition, analytical cookies are used that do not invade your privacy. A cookie is a small text file that is stored on your computer, tablet or smartphone on your first visit to the website. The cookies used by the Nijmegen Career Event are necessary for the technical use of our website and ease of use. These cookies ensure that the website works correctly. The Nijmegen Career Event can also optimize its website with these cookies. You can opt out of these cookies by changing the settings in your web browser to stop storing your cookies. In addition, you can delete all previously stored information through your web browser's settings.

Objections

Personal data security

The Nijmegen Career Event takes the protection of your personal data seriously and takes appropriate measures to prevent abuse, loss, unauthorized access, unwanted dissemination and unauthorized modifications. The Nijmegen Career Event website uses a reliable SSL certificate to ensure that your personal data is kept safe.

Reporting duty of data breaches

The Nijmegen Career Event is obliged to report data breaches. A databreach occurs when data is lost or processed incorrectly. If a data breach occurs, the Nijmegen Career Event is obliged to inform participants. When a data breach occurs, the Nijmegen Career Event informs the parties involved within 72 hours. After a data breach, the Nijmegen Career Event investigates where the leak occurred and how a similar leak can be prevented in the future.
